SINGER. Murray Singer, 85, of Boca Raton, FL, died Thursday (Dec., 25, 1997). Mr. Singer was a high school science teacher and department chairman in Great Neck, NY, for over 32 years, and retired in 1972. Formerly of Great Neck and Poughquag, NY, he moved to Boca Raton after his retirement. Born in the Bronx, NY, Mr. Singer was the son of Sara (Greenberg) and Max Singer. A graduate of New York University, as a chemical engineer, Mr. Singer first worked in the oil industry in Warren, PA and then began his teaching career. He received a Master's degree at Union College, Schenectady, NY in 1969. He is survived by a daughter, Jean (Singer) Foster of Poughkeepsie, NY; sons: Norman Singer and wife, Sandra, of McLean, VA, Paul Singer and wife, Katherine, of West Hartford; eight grandchildren: Beth and Jeff Foster, Melissa, Brooks, Ryan, and Taylor Singer, and Amy and Evan Singer; and brother, Raymond Singer of Laguna Hills, CA. He was preceded in death in 1990 by Loretta (LaMarca) Singer, his wife of 53 years. He also leaves his companion, Mrs. Ann White, of Norwalk.
